School Supply List

2017-2018

As you prepare your student for the 2017-18 school year, please review this list of necessary materials. The basic supplies which are applicable to most 7th and 8th grade classes are listed first. An additional list follows with items that are specific to particular subject areas.

Supplies Needed by All Advance JH Students

- ❖ One 1 inch Binder with pockets for each core class ~ Four 1" binders in all
- ❖ 7 folders with pockets and with prongs
- ❖ (color coded for each class; three-hole punched, if possible)
 - Orange – Computer
 - Blue – English Language Arts
 - Green – Science
 - Red – Social Studies
 - Yellow – Math
 - 2 folders of any color or design for elective classes
- ❖ Pencil pouch with binder rings for ELA
- ❖ Pens - blue, black, and red (several packages)
- ❖ Pencils - regular #2 or mechanical (several packages)
- ❖ Loose leaf paper (several packages)
- ❖ 4 black dry erase markers (use on sm. white-boards in classes)
- ❖ 2 highlighters
- ❖ Colored pencils, washable markers, scissors, glue
- ❖ TI-30Xa Scientific Calculator
- ❖ 1 box of Kleenex, GermX and Clorox Wipes to give to your Advisory teacher

Supplies Needed for Certain Subjects

- ❖ Physical Education (7th and 8th grade) - Any short-sleeve T-shirt with no offensive logos or messages, shorts (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee), socks, and tennis shoes
- ❖ Life Skills – one 70 page spiral notebook
- ❖ Art – Spiral bound sketchbook
- ❖ Band - All items should be purchased at Shivelbine's Music Store - 573-334-5216. Contact Shivelbine's Music to purchase method books. Buy reeds, oil, rosin, accessory items, etc. as needed for each instrument.
