

Board Policy Regarding Repeating High School Classes.

Students in grades 9-12 shall be allowed to repeat at most 2 courses or classes during their high school career once a passing grade has been achieved. Once a student has earned a passing grade in a course or class, that grade shall remain on the student's official transcript and shall be used in calculation of the student's semester and overall GPA until/if the class has been repeated. The higher grade shall be used for GPA calculation. No repeated classes or courses may be used for Valedictorian or Salutatorian calculation. Before a student may repeat a class/course they, along with a parent or guardian, must confer with the school counselor.
